To become a ZNA Assistant Certified Judge, an applicant should take an examination

The guidance to take the ZNA Assistant Certified Judge Exam

1) Application form

Fill out your application form and send it to the head office by the 20th of December of the previous year of the exam. The application shall not be accepted when it doesn't fulfill the entire conditions to apply.

2) Venue

Usually, the venue is the meeting room of the 2nd floor of Tokyo Ryutsu Center Building, where the AJNPA (Shinkokai) All Japan Nishikigoi Show is held. The building is just in front of the Ryutsu Center Station of Monorail line between Hamamatsu-cho and Haneda Domestic Airport. Confirm the latest information.

3) Schedule

Usually, the exam is held on the Saturday morning during the AJNPA All Japan Combined Show.

4) Fees

Please pay the following fees at the registration, or credit card is available in prior.

Exam fee for Assistant Certified Judge Examination ¥15,000JPY

5) Items that you wear at the exam.

- a) Jacket and tie
- b) ZNA member pin (If you don't have it, you can buy it on the exam day, costing ¥1,500)
- c) ZNA name tag, pen

6) Examination

- a) Rank 5 koi for 7 minutes at the koi tank. See the attached sheet.
- b) Make brief comments on the 5 koi in the meeting room.
- c) Group interview about the ranked koi.

7) Result

The result of the examination will be announced on the next day.

8) Registration and Judge emblem

Registration fee is ¥30,000JPY

Emblem is ¥6,000JPY
